

Aprovecho la ocasión para saludar al Señor Presidente muy atentamente.

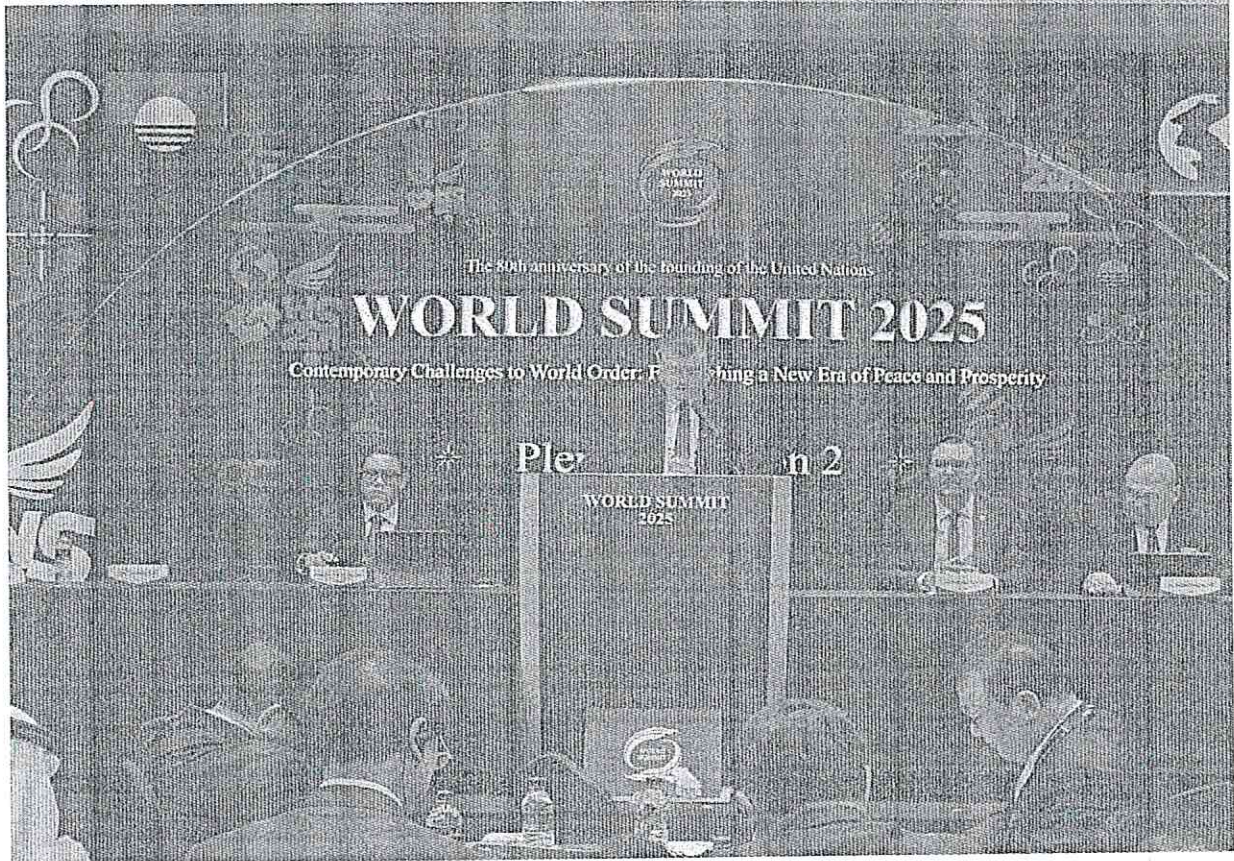
